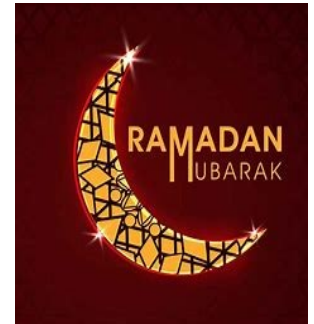
Ramadan Mubarak
