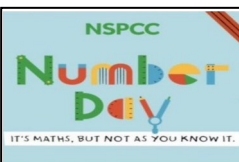


## Eid Party Day Celebrations—Thursday 20th May

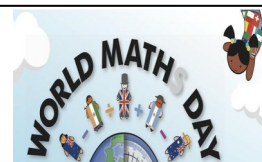
