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## PARENTS' AFTERNOON TELEPHONE MEETINGS

### Thursday 8th and Friday 9th July 2021

Our final Parents' Afternoon for this academic year will be on **Thursday 8th July** from **2:00pm to 4:30pm via telephone** and **Friday 9th July** from **1:30pm to 3:30pm via telephone meetings**. Children must be collected from the playground at **1.35pm on Thursday 8th July** and at the normal time of **12:55pm on Friday 9th July**, so staff are available to contact all families via telephone.

Appointments for telephone meetings with your child's class teacher can be booked on **ParentMail**. **We are asking parents to be available at the time that they have booked to ensure that class teacher is able to speak to all families**. There is an option when booking your appointment to leave a **note**, where you can enter the best contact number to call you on. Please ensure you have booked your appointment by **Tuesday 13th July**.

Children will be taking home their **school reports** on **Tuesday 6th July**. Please ensure that you read your child's report prior to your telephone appointment, so you can discuss it with your child's class teacher

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION COVID UPDATE

As mentioned previously, the easing of Covid-19 restrictions in England has been delayed by to 19th July, which takes us right up to the end of term. Due to the restrictions in place, we are still not in a position to allow groups of parents on site. Therefore, we must ensure that everyone's safety comes first and continue to follow our risk assessments.

As a result, we will not be able to invite parents and families into school for end of year events such as graduations, sports days, assemblies and workshops. Parents' Afternoon will be carried out via telephone conversations with class teachers. We will keep you updated with further information.

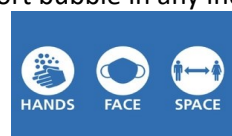
Please can all parents/carers ensure that the school has the correct contact details. It is vital that you keep the school informed of any changes in contact numbers or addresses. During these unprecedented times it is even more vital that parents keep communication lines open with the school in case of emergencies or class closures. Please inform the school immediately if your family is required to self-isolate due to contact with Coronavirus. Remember, do not send your child or children into school if any members of your family are being tested for Coronavirus.

It is also really important that everyone respects the measures school has introduced to keep everyone safe. Please ensure that all families continue to follow advice.

- Wash hands: keep washing your hands regularly for 20 seconds.
- Cover face: wear a face covering in enclosed spaces.
- Let the fresh air in your homes, open windows for short, sharp bursts of 10 to 15 minutes regularly throughout the day.
- Make space: stay at least 2 metres apart - or 1 metre with a face covering or other precautions.
- In Birmingham you must not socialise with anybody outside of your household or support bubble in any indoor setting, whether at home or in a public place.
