Adderley Primary School takes poor attendance very seriously and will take action where parents/carers fail to ensure their children attend school regularly. Every child should achieve an attendance target of 100% and we recognise the good work many parents do in ensuring their children achieve this.

Extended Leave

If you are thinking of taking your child out of school for an extended period, please come to the office to complete an Exceptional Circumstances Leave In Term Time Form. Adderley Primary School will not grant requests for leave in term time and any leave will be recorded as unauthorised absence.

Parents must be aware that they are at risk of losing their child's school place or being fined by the Local Authority, so far this year 6 families have been fined by Birmingham City Council for taking extending leave.

Lateness
