Parent/Carer Code of Conduct and Communication

At Adderley Primary School, we believe it is important to:

- •Work in partnership with Parents to support their child's learning.
- Create a safe, respectful and inclusive environment for Pupils, Staff and Parents.
- •Model appropriate behaviour for our Pupils at all times.

To help us do this, we set clear expectations and guidelines on behaviour for all members of our community. This includes our pupils through the Positive Pupil Behaviour Policy.

The Parent/Carers Code of Conduct Policy aims to help the school work together with Parents/Carers by setting guidelines on appropriate behaviour. Unacceptable behaviour cannot be tolerated by either the school or the Governing Body, both of which take this matter extremely seriously due to the considerable distress such behaviour causes to the recipients. In addition, the School has a legal duty to ensure that its pupils, staff and visitors are treated with respect and that they are not subjected to verbal abuse, physical intimidation or humiliation.

We use the term 'Parents' and 'Carers' to refer to:

- •Anyone with legal Parental/Carers responsibility for a pupil.
- •Anyone caring for a child (such as grandparents, foster carers or child-minders).

There has been a small number of incidents where Parents/Carers have been verbally aggressive and extremely rude to our staff members and the Leadership Team. We have had to report these Parents/Carers to the Police, who have taken action. We understand that at times you may have concerns that you need to raise but please do so in a respectful and professional manner.

The Governing Body has stated: NO MEMBER OF STAFF OR ANY MEMBER OF THE LEADERSHIP TEAM WILL NOT BE PUT INTO ANY SITUATIONS WHERE THEY ARE VERBALLY OR PHYSICALLY ABUSED. WE WILL NOT TOLEATE THIS. THIS MAY LEAD TO A BAN FOR THE PARENT AND/OR CARER ISSUED BY THE LOCAL **AUTHORITY.**

VAPES

We have had a small number of incidents, where children have brought in Vapes or amounts of money from home. We have and will deal with these issues following our relevant polices.

Parents/Carers will be held responsible for these types of incidents. The school will work in partnership with our Parents and Carers, however, it will be and is Parental responsibility to deal with these concerns at home as well.

MOBILES PHONES WITHIN SCHOOL

As part of our Safeguarding Procedures Parents or Carers are strictly prohibited from recording any meetings using any mobile or recording devices. Also Parents and Carers are prohibited from using mobile phones in the school playground. There are signs up all around the school and in the playground, please adhere to this policy.
