### Unicef Fundraising for Children of Gaza—Thursday 26th October

In light of the ongoing crisis in Gaza, as a **Unicef Gold Rights Respecting School** our school has decided to organise a special Fundraising Day to support the children affected by the difficult circumstances in the region. The conflict in Gaza has resulted in immense suffering, particularly for the most vulnerable members of society - the children.

Our goal is to raise both awareness and financial assistance for those who need it the most. This Fundraising Day will be an opportunity for our children to learn about empathy, compassion, and the importance of helping others in times of crisis. All our funds will be donated to Unicef, who is working on the ground in Gaza, despite the challenging humanitarian and security situation. They are working with partners to deliver life-saving supplies, including medicines and clean water, as well as mental health support.

To help us raise the most we can, we are asking our pupils to donate any unwanted items such as gifts, toys and books (which are in good condition) to be sold on Fundraising Day. On the day children can come to school in **non-uniform** and donate 50p towards the fund, other activities will include **Bouncy Castle, Face Painting, Mehndi, Sweet Stall, Cake Stall, Clothing Sale, Food Stalls, Raffle** and lots more!!!

Access to the event will be through the Arden Road Gates. **Children will need to bring money to spend during the fundraising event.**

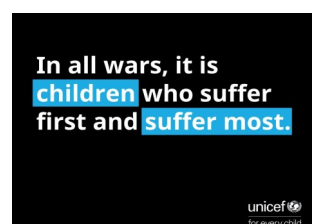
