LATENESS

From Monday 13th November if your child/children arrive late to school, Parents/Carers must now sign the child/children into school using the iPad in the main reception area. Children will not be allowed into school unless a Parent/Carer has registered their child.



When a pupil arrives late, they miss out on essential instructions given at the beginning of the school day. Poor punctuality can also cause social disruption as children may feel uncomfortable and embarrassed arriving to the classroom when everyone else is already settled. When a pupil arrives late it disrupts the teacher and the rest of the class, compromising everyone's learning.

The school day commences at **8.35am** and all pupils are expected to be in school on time in readiness for the start of the school day.

School registers open at 8.35am and close at 8.50am. Pupils arriving after 8.45am but before 8.50am will be marked as late in the register. After 8:50am, all absence will be marked as unauthorised until the reason for absence has been established.

Parents/Carers must sign children in if arriving after 8.45am using the new iPad that is located in the main reception area.

Please note that Parents/Carers must accompany a child/children into school if late and must not drop off at the gate.

Good timekeeping matters. Did you know that being 15 minutes late each day for a year is the same as missing nearly two weeks of school? EVERY DAY COUNTS but every minute is important! LOST MINUTES = LOST LEARNING

Please consider the impact of any absences or lateness will have on your child's education.

Card Payments Accepted

From January 2024, the school will be able to accept card payments at the school office. Parents/Carers should still use Parentmail for Trips and Dinner payments.

Card payments made at the office can be taken for school uniform, late charges, lost library books, replacement planners and even if you want to donate to charity.
