Creative Curriculum

Class Book - Paddington at the Tower by Michael Bond Our curriculum this half term will be focusing on Magnificent Monarchs where children will be writing a recount on their trip to Warwick Castle. Also they will write a character description on Paddington/Mr Brown.

At home ensure that your child knows all their high frequency words, also ensure that you read lots of fiction and nonfiction books.



In RMSE children will be learning to reflect on the Christmas story and the reasons for Jesus' birth.

At home you can research the different ways to celebrate Christmas.

PSHEC

Children will begin the term exploring Article 19: Protection from violence, abuse, or neglect. They will explore why it's important to be kind and caring. Furthermore, children will identify how to protect the environment and care for animals. At home discuss the importance of treating

everyone with kindness and care.
