What your child is learning this half term

Maths

We will be looking at place value and addition and subtraction within numbers to 20. We will also start looking at numbers to 50, identifying numbers one more and one less and partitioning to find tens and ones.

At home, practise 2x, 10x and 5- times tables. Your child will be tested on their times tables weekly.

Science

This half term we will continue with our topic 'Animals including Humans'. To build on our understanding from Autumn 2, we will now begin to compare the structure of humans and animals.

At home, research and discuss how are humans and animals similar and different.

RMSE

This half term, we will be looking at the theme 'Jesus as a friend'. We will focus on when it is easy and difficult to show friendship and to explore when Jesus may have found it difficult.

At home, encourage your child to use their manners and show kindness to others

English

Year 1 will write a fairy tale narrative based upon the text 'Nadiya's Bake Me a Story'. We will also look at writing a method in the form of a recipe card.

At home, research recipes and support your child to write a short recipe on their favourite food.

ART/DT

This half term, in Art we will be experimenting with lines and shades by drawing a range of fruits and vegetables. In DT we will focus on textiles by designing and making their own hand puppets.

At home, research primary and secondary colours and make a picture using these colours.

Homework

Reading, Writing and Maths homework is set weekly on **Purple Mash every Thursday**. Home reader books will be changed on a weekly basis. Don't forget to **read with your child and comment in their home reading record book**. Please remind your child to bring their home reading book and record back to school **every Monday**.
