

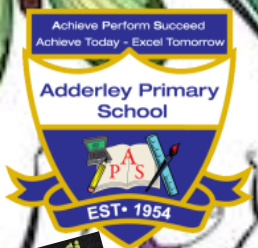
Year 2 Curriculum Information

What your child is learning this half term

Creative Curriculum

Our curriculum this half term will be focusing on minibeasts, and children will begin to explore non-fiction books. Children will write a non-chronological report on interesting facts about mini beasts. They will also write a shape poem to entertain the Adderley Community.

At home ensure that your child knows all their common exception words, also ensure that you read a range of non-fiction books.

RMSE

In RMSE children will be exploring Judaism and the celebration of Passover. They will be able to understand how Jewish people have a special relationship with God. Also, the children will explore Islam and will understand the importance of praying.

At home, you can research and discuss the importance of why Muslims pray.



PSHEC

Children will begin the term exploring our diverse society and the importance of upholding British Values. Furthermore, children will explore the differences between belief, fact and opinion and look at reliable sources.

At home, research the meanings of 'reliable, genuine, and source'. Discuss current news using the key vocabulary.

Music

In music children will explore orchestral instruments and listen to analyse an orchestral version of a traditional story. Children will write a play script and select appropriate musical sounds to accompany it.

At home, encourage your children to research different types of orchestral instruments.



Maths

This term children will begin to look at Money and Multiplication and Division, linking to times tables. The children will then apply their Mathematical knowledge to reasoning and problem-solving activities.

At home, support your child with learning their times tables using Times Table Rockstar's. Focus on 3-, 4- and 8-times tables.



Physical Education

In 20, children will focus on 'Send and Return.' Children will begin to hit and return a ball using hands and racquets with some consistency. In 2C, children will be learning how to 'Attack, Defend and Shoot.'

At home children can express themselves through dancing. Additionally, children can practise their kicking skills.



Computing

Our topic this term is 'computing systems and networks'. Children will develop their understanding of technology and how it can help us. They will start to become familiar with the different components of a computer.

At home encourage children to access the BBC Bitesize website, 'How can computers be connected?' and complete the interactive quiz.

Homework

Children are given online weekly on Purple Mash. Homework is set on Thursday and should be completed by the following Monday. ILP projects will be given as half-termly tasks where children will lead their own learning by completing a creative project or research linked to the ILP topic. Home reader books are changed weekly, please ensure your child writes two comments a week in their home planner.



Science

We are learning all about 'Living Things and Their Habitats'. Children will learn about a variety of habitats and the animals that live there. Moreover, children will explore the difference between things that are living, dead and alive.

At home children can research a range of habitats and find out if minibeasts have a favourite colour.



Geography

In Geography children will be exploring the impact the climate has on minibeasts. Children will also explore maps and sketch their own birds eye view map.

At home children can draw a map of an imaginary zoo.

Art and DT

In ADT children will be learning about mechanisms and will make a moving monster. In Art they will draw, sketch and paint minibeasts.

At home children can research the features of minibeasts.
