



Year 6 Spring 2 Topic is: Islamic Golden Age

SATS REVISION INFORMATION

As you are aware, the children will be taking their upcoming SATS test in SPaG, Reading and Maths. Within lessons, we will be revisiting key strategies that children can use in order to answer questions in all areas of the curriculum. This term, children will be consolidating their knowledge about all of their topics they have covered this year. Children will continue to develop their speed and accuracy in answering questions.

Science - What we are learning Light

Children will be developing their understanding of how light waves travel out from different sources. They will learn about the laws of reflection (angles of reflection). They will investigate why shadows are the same shape as the objects that cast them.

Maths - What we are learning

- Using the four operations to systematically solve word problems.
- Increasing their stamina with arithmetic style questions.
- Consolidating their learning with Factors, Multiples, Squares and Square Roots; Volume and Area; Statistics

Revision at home:

Recalling multiplication and division facts up to 20^2 .
Multiplying and dividing decimals with numbers up to 4 digits.
Find properties of numbers, such as: Prime Numbers, Factors and Multiples.
Find fractions and percentages of amounts, such as, 15%, 65% and 45%.
Use the four operations for Mixed, Proper and Improper fractions by whole numbers.
Revise measure and draw angles.

PE on Thursday – What we are learning

This half term Year 6 will be taking part in athletics. They need to practise their catching, throwing, balancing and fielding skills. Please ensure PE uniform is correct, including appropriate footwear.

At home: Encourage your child to practise the skills they have learnt in PE.

English- What we are learning

- Reading focus: Apply their reading strategies and apply learning using the 5 different question types during Guided Reading sessions. Children will also focus on inference and will be answering 3mark questions.
- Grammar focus: Word classes, such as Prepositions and different types of nouns, punctuation, including speech and brackets.

Revision at home:

Revise key Grammar terms, such as: Determiners, Preposition, and Subordinate Clauses.
Revise Spellings consistently and apply them to sentences. (All previous spellings are in planners).
Access Reading SATs papers online and practise how to answer certain questions.
